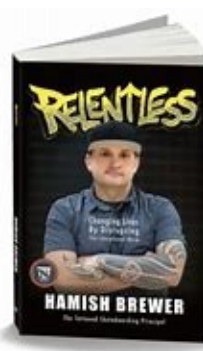
Update from Kristy McGrath, Superintendent

Hello Adirondack Students, Parents, Staff and Community,

We have had a busy, successful, and fun-filled opening to the 2022-23 school year. As you look through the fall newsletter, you will see many amazing things taking place at Adirondack. I wanted to share with you a few fun and exciting items to get things started.



1. **Adirondack staff kicked off the 2022-23 school year with a presentation from Mr. Hamish Brewer** on September 1st. Hamish travels and speaks world-wide, and brought a ton of inspiration and insight to us. He is originally from New Zealand, is currently a doctoral student at Virginia Tech, and is the best-selling author of the book *Relentless*. Mr. Brewer has proven success, by turning low performing schools into high achieving schools, being named Principal of the Year by many organizations. Relationships and respect are the most critical components of his success. He is known as the tattooed, skateboarding principal. 2. Adirondack's performance and participation in the **New York State 3-8 ELA and mathematics exams** is a priority for our district. I would like us to celebrate some impressive results, in that over **90% of students participated** in these exams, and our **highest proficiency was at Boonville Elementary in math grade 5**, with 61% of students earning a level 3 or 4. There are many factors to help us evaluate our instructional program, and the state data is helpful and necessary for us to gain this knowledge. Great work!

3. I am so impressed to work with such a quality staff. We have staff members doing amazing things each and every day. I wanted to point out a few highlights:

-Justin Wiedrick is a finalist for the New York State 2022 Presidential Awards for Excellence in Mathematics and Science Teaching. He is down to the final two selected in our entire state for mathematics K-6. We are eagerly awaiting to hear if he is the winner, but either way, we are extremely proud of Justin.

-Phil Puleo was named Coach of the Year, All Mohawk Valley. Mr. Puleo teaches High School Physical Education, and he is our Varsity Baseball Coach. Phil led our 2022 baseball team to the state final 4 this spring, and is very deserving of this recognition.

-Dan Granato is a Middle/High School Technology Teacher, who was a Harbor Freight Tools for Schools Prize for Teaching Excellence finalist. Unfortunately Mr. Granato didn't make the top 20. He was however in the top 50, and was awarded \$1000 to his program. Dan is committed and driven, intends to apply again next year, and we are confident he has a great shot at making the top 20. If chosen in the top 20, this year's prize was \$50,000 (a large portion going to the school/program and a smaller portion going to the teacher).



Finally, attendance matters. I want to stress that if students and staff are sick, we do not want them to attend school. However, we need to get back on track after Covid with emphasizing the importance of good attendance, well-rested students who are on time to school, and a focus on high expectations. Please continue to support us in this partnership!

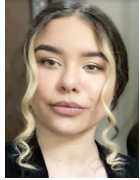


Adirondack Welcomes New Faculty and Staff to our Team!



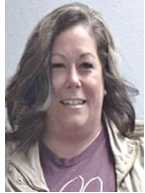
Brandie Collins –*MS Principal*

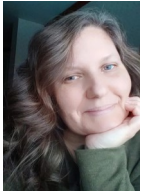
Teresa Grower– *BE Office Specialist I*

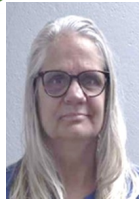
Kelsey Charbonneau–*American Sign Language Teacher*

Valarie Mudrie— *Connected Community Schools, Program Manager*

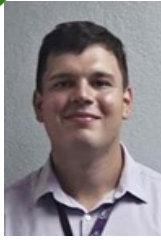

Jessica Hardy— *HS Connected Community Schools*

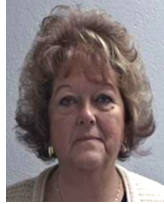

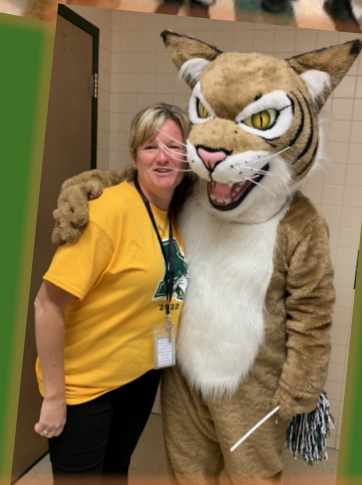
WILDCAT WEDNESDAYS

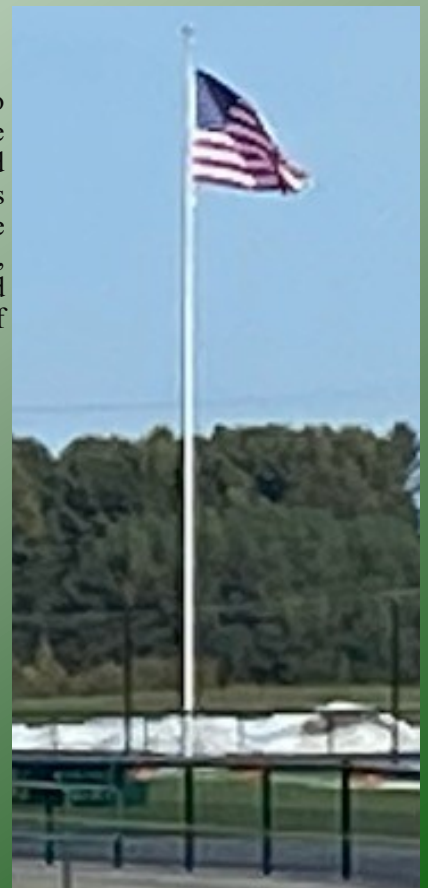


New Flag Pole Project

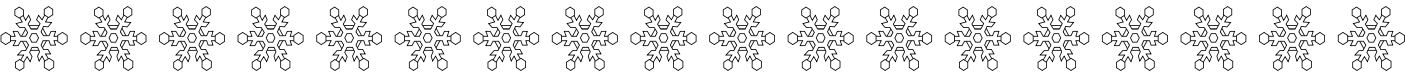

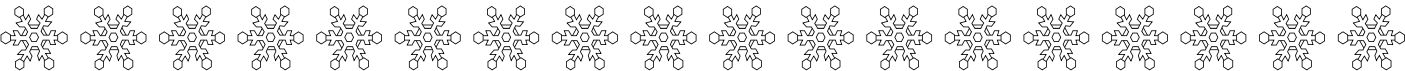

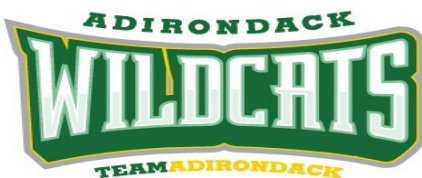
